

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
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Research Question

During the PAST 30 DAYS, how often did you feel...

- So sad that nothing could cheer you up;
- 2. Nervous;
- 3. Restless or fidgety;
- 4. Hopeless;
- 5. That everything was an effort; and
- 6. Worthless.

The following options are given for describing frequency:

- NONE of the time;
- A LITTLE of the time;
- 3. SOME of the time;
- 4. MOST of the time; and
- 5. ALL of the time
